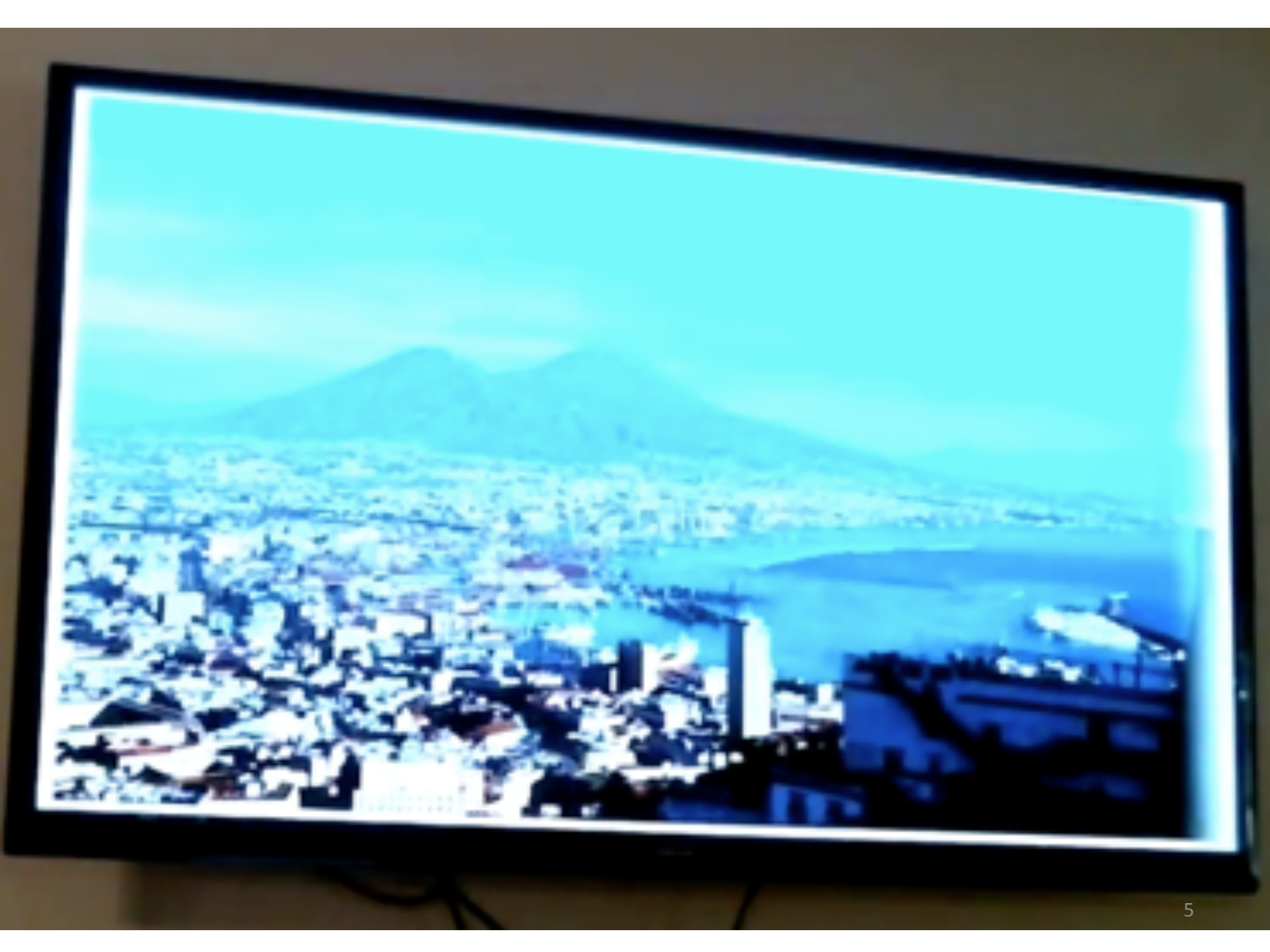

## St. Alphonsus, Childhood 1696 – 13

- ▶ 1. First son – raised to keep the family name.
- ▶ 2. Home tutored
- ▶ 3. Catholic Education
- ▶ 4. Spiritual Direction & weekly confession
- ▶ 5. Participated in the life of the Nobles
- ▶ 6. Devotion to Mary and Jesus Crucified
- ▶ 7. Law school – Graduated at 16

- ▶ 1. Giuseppe designs for his son
- ▶ 2. High standards for being a lawyer
- ▶ 3. Catholic practices of his faith
- ▶ 4. Day of Conversion. August 29, 1723

- ▶ 2. Marie Celeste Crostarolo 1731
- ▶ 3. Vows of first community 1732
- ▶ 4. Bishop Falcoia
- ▶ 5. Gennaro Samelli
- ▶ 6. Mission to the abandoned
- ▶ 7. Writer













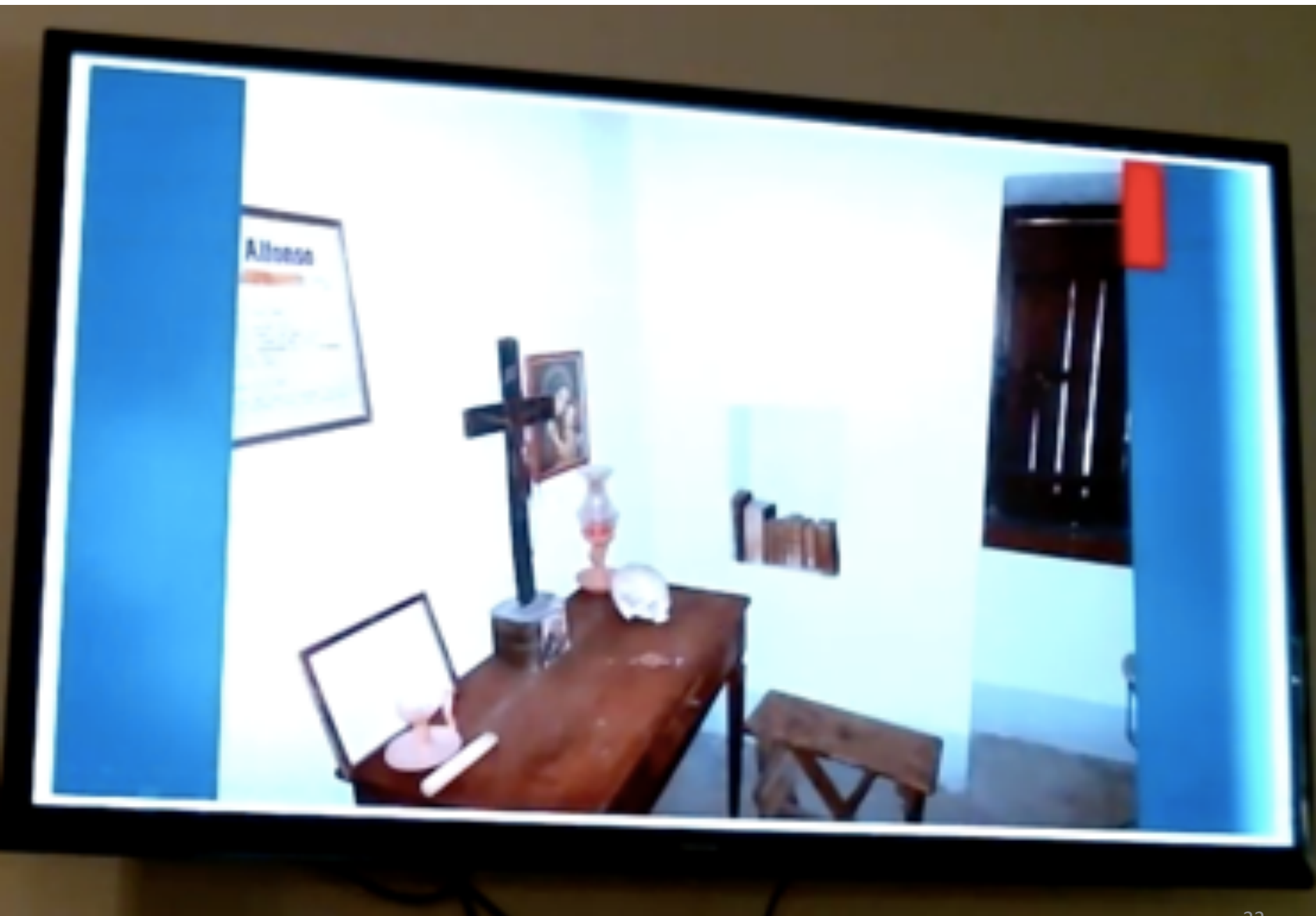













## St. Alphonsus – the Bishop 1762 - 75

- ▶ 3. Continued his written works





- ▶ 3. Dies in Paganis - August 1 1787





# Recognitions of St. Alphonsus

- ▶ 1. Beatified - September 1814
- ▶ 2. Canonized - May 26, 1839
- ▶ 3. Doctor of the Church - March 23, 1871
- ▶ 4. Patron of Moralists & Confessors - April 26, 1950
- ▶ 5. Arthritis Victims seek his aid





## Recognitions of St. Alphonsus

- ▶ 1. Beatified – September 1846
- ▶ 2. Canonized – May 30, 1847
- ▶ 3. Doctor of the Church – 1875
- ▶ 4. Patron of Moralists – 1920
- ▶ 5. Archdiocesan Patron – 1925
